320 to 360 stag hunts are very popular with hunters that want more bang for their buck. You can shoot two of these stag for the cost of one big stag and take home over 640 gross inches of hard antler.

Hunters wanting to shoot multiple trophies and keep within their budget find these impressive stags the perfect fit for their hunt.

Bow hunting or rifle, husband and wife hunters, Father and son hunts, you will not be disappointed in the quality of these stags.











Bull TAHR HUNTS

If your passion in life is mountain hunting then you won't find a more exciting mountain hunt than the Bull Tahr.

We have numerous hunting areas from private land to government concession land. Private land is well tracked for 4x4 vehicle access and is very accessible for all ages.

Our concession land is only accessible by helicopter and we spike camp on high ridge tops and remote valleys right among the animals. Our concession land will put you in some of the worlds most spectacular mountain scenery. A good level of fitness is required to truly appreciate this type of country.

The most impressive aspect of the Bull Tahr is their long lion like mane and shaggy body hair. To achieve the best quality capes all of our Tahr hunts are conducted from late April through to August.





The New Zealand mountains are well populated with the Alpine chamois, their athletic ability will leave every hunter in awe. All of our Alpine Chamois hunts are conducted on government concession land. The best hunting opportunities come from using a helicopter to access the high mountain ridge tops and hunting each day from spike camps. Chamois are such a versatile trophy, they can be found at the top of the mountain, all the way down to the creek bottoms, they can be hunted most of the year, full summer coats are just as impressive as their winter coats. A combination of Alpine Chamois and Bull Tahr complete the true mountain hunting experience of New Zealand.



Captain James Cook on his next voyage to NZ brought the Arapawa Ram and Alpine Goat and liberated them on to the coastal Islands off NZ as a source of meat for new settlers. Today the Arapawa Ram can only be found in New Zealand. These smaller game animals make for a fun hunt, suitable for all ages and a great story when on show in your trophy room.



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
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
